

## CT Cervical Spine

SCOUT						AP and Lat
AXIAL ST	Axial	MPR	Soft Tissue	2 mm	2 mm	Skull base to T2
AXIAL BONE	Axial	MPR	Bone	2 mm	2 mm	Skull base to T2
CORONAL BONE	Coronal	MPR	Bone	2 mm	2 mm	Skin to Skin
SAGITTAL BONE	Sagittal	MPR	Soft Tissue	2 mm	2 mm	Skin to Skin

### Notes:

- Bone algorithm/kernel
- Noncontrast for trauma and DDD. Contrast for indication of infection or tumor
- For CT Cervical W/ or W/WO- include post contrast 3mm axial, coronal and sagittal MPRs in soft tissue window
- For CT myelogram, roll patient 360 degrees prior to scanning to mix contrast in the thecal sac

### Contrast:

- Contrast Type: Per site
- Contrast Dose: 75-100 cc
- Delay: 60 sec
